GALVALUME® PLUS **25 YEAR, 6-MONTH LIMITED WARRANTY**

Corrugated Industries of Florida, Inc.'s ("Seller") hot dipped aluminum zinc alloy-coated GALVALUME® PLUS sheet steel, with a coating weight of AZ55, sold for use as unpainted steel building, roofing and siding panels, if erected within the Continental United States WILL NOT rupture, fail structurally or perforate within a period of 25 years and 6 months after shipment from our manufacturing plant as a result of corrosion caused by exposure to normal atmospheric conditions.

This limited warranty **DOES NOT APPLY** to sheet exposed at any time to corrosive or aggressive atmospheric conditions, including but not limited to:

- 1) Areas subject to saltwater marine atmospheres or to constant spraying of either salt or fresh water.
- 2) Areas subject to fallout or exposure to corrosive chemical, fumes, ash, cement dust or animal waste.
- 3) Areas subject to water runoff from lead or copper flashings or areas in metallic contact with lead or copper.
- 4) Conditions/circumstances where corrosive fumes or condensates are generated or released inside the building.

This limited warranty **DOES NOT APPLY** in the event of:

- A) Bends less than 2T for sheet thickness 0.030" and thinner and less than 4T for sheet thickness 0.031" and thicker.
- B) Slopes of the roof or sections of the roof flatter than ¼:12.
- C) Mechanical, chemical or other damage sustained during shipment, storage, forming fabrication, during or after erection.
- D) Forming which incorporates severe reverse bending or which subjects coating to alternate compression and tension.
- E) Failure to provide free drainage of water, including internal condensation, from overlaps on all other surfaces of the sheets or panels.
- F) Failure to remove debris from overlaps and all other surfaces of the sheets or panels.
- G) Damage caused to the metallic coating by improper scouring or cleaning procedures.
- H) Deterioration of the panels caused by contact with green or wet lumber or wet storage stain caused by water damage or condensation.
- I) Presence of damp insulation, soil, vegetation or other corrosive materials in contact with or close proximity to the panel.
- J) This warranty does not apply in the event of deterioration to the panels caused directly or indirectly by panel contact with fasteners. Selection of suitable long-lasting fasteners to be used with GALVALUME® PLUS sheet roofing and siding rests solely with the buyer.
- K) Damage to the GALVALUME® PLUS coating by cascading water.
- L) Damage caused by cutting panels with an abrasive blade saw or other means which damages the GALVALUME® PLUS coating.
- M) Damages to the coated metal caused by contact with, or water runoff from, lead, copper graphite or dissimilar material. This includes A/C condensation.
- N) The GALVALUME® PLUS coating is subject to variances in spangle from coil to coil which may result in noticeable shade variation in installed panels. The GALVALUME® PLUS coating is also subject to differential weathering after panel installation. Panels may appear to be different shades due to this weathering characteristic. Variances in spangle and weathering characteristics shall not be covered under this limited warranty.

This limited warranty shall be subject to the stipulations, limitations and conditions hereinafter set forth:

- 1) Seller's liability for breach of this limited warranty shall be limited exclusively to the cost of either repairing or replacing non-conforming, rupturing, perforating or structurally failing panels.
- 2) Seller shall not in any event be liable for the cost of labor expended by others on any non-conforming, rupturing, perforating or structurally failing sheet or for any special, indirect, or consequential loss of profits or any other incidental, general, special or compensatory damages to anyone by reason of the fact that such panels shall have been non-conforming, rupturing, perforating, or structurally failing.
- 3) This limited warranty will not extend to or cover damages to the material due to shipping, improper handling (whether pre-erection or during erection), improper storage, improper erection or improper installation (which includes failure to permit drainage of standing water.)

- 4) Claims must be reported in writing to Seller within thirty (30) days after discovery of non-conformance, rupture, perforation or structural failing and Seller shall be given a reasonable opportunity (which shall not be less than thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of notification) to inspect the panels claimed to be non-conforming, rupturing, perforating or structural failing. Adequate identification of the material involved in the claim, including date of installation, Seller's order/invoice number and date of shipment must be established by Buyer. A copy of this document must be presented to Seller at time of claim.
- 5) Buyer shall exercise diligence in inspection of sheets as received from Seller so as to mitigate any expenses to Seller under this limited warranty.
- 6) Panel repaired or sheet product furnished under this limited warranty shall not extend the original limited warranty time period hereunder.
- 7) This limited warranty shall extend to the original Building Owner and is non-assignable and/or non-transferable. Should the owner become insolvent, bankrupt, make an assignment for the benefit of its creditors, or for any other reason discontinue its normal or regular business practice, this limited warranty shall forthwith become null and void and of no legal effect.
- 8) Seller may cancel this limited warranty on thirty days written notice to Buyer, except with respect to sheets already covered by this limited warranty. This limited warranty does not apply to any goods sold prior to the job and date this document is signed. Buyer agrees that its use is made in reliance upon this limited warranty and not upon any other written or oral presentation of Seller. This limited warranty cancels and supersedes any other warranty or statement of performance made in the past or in the future by Seller unless such statement is subsequently made in writing as an express amendment of this document.
- 9) The rights and obligations of the parties hereunder shall not be governed by the provisions of the UN convention on contracts for the international Sale of Goods; rather, these rights and obligations shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida, USA and jurisdiction and venue is fixed in Hillsborough County, Florida.
